## THE LONDON OPEN COLLEGE FEDERATION

The London Open College Federation (LOCF) provides a comprehensive framework for the accreditation of adult learning.

LOCF Credits are awarded at four levels.

### CREDITS

One Credit is based on a notional learning time of 30 hours, which is the total of directed and independent study time that the learner will need, on average, to achieve specified outcomes.

### LEVELS

Credits are awarded at four levels, depending on the degree, complexity and independence of learning. The levels apply across all types of learning, whatever the curriculum area or method of delivery. They provide a comprehensive framework within which any learning programme can be located. The levels are:

- Level 1 *the development of basic skills, concepts and practical activities;*
- Level 2 *the consolidation of existing skills and the introduction of new skills, competences and areas of learning;*
- Level 3 *the extension and application of skills and competences and the introduction of independent learning techniques;*
- Level 4 *the development and independent application of a range of critical, reflective, creative and problem-solving skills and competences.*

# THE LONDON OPEN COLLEGE FEDERATION


